SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Dynalabs specializes in laboratory quality assurance testing services of compounded medications. Natividad has used Dynalabs for several years and has been satisfied with their turnaround times and their customer service. NMC uses Dynalabs for sterility testing, potency testing, stability testing, endotoxin testing, and beyond use dating as required by state and federal law and regulation. Potency, beyond use dating, and stability testing help ensure patients receive a sufficient medication dose. Sterility and endotoxin testing ensure that the medications patients receive do not contain bacterial contamination. Through this testing not only are individual products tested but the quality of the compounding process itself is measured.

This new agreement replaces an older agreement with Dynalabs, LLC from 2015 and contains updated terms and pricing.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Office of County Counsel has reviewed and approved this agreement as to form, and the Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The agreement has also been reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee on January 8, 2021 and by its Board of Trustees on January 8, 2021.

FINANCING:

NMC has contracted with Truven since 2009 for the use of the IBM database(s) and analytic tools. IBM is now partnering with Virtusa Corporation to provide these same services.

Care Discovery is a database and reporting system that provides NMC with a dashboard of critical benchmarks and objective, fact-based information necessary to make quick, confident decisions in support of the hospital's quality improvement initiatives. The database and reporting system allows NMC to: evaluate our performance as compared to peer hospitals; and evaluate our outcomes including the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) national indicators, complications, and risk-adjusted mortality and resource metrics. It provides NMC with the capability to drill into transaction-level details to identify specific opportunities for improving the process of care. The database and reporting system allows NMC to compare patient-care patterns among physicians and compare expected results to observed results. The database is used to run many required reports for Joint Commission accreditation.

The Care Discovery Quality Measures database and reporting system provides NMC with the tools to comply with the Joint Commission and Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requirement for quarterly reporting of clinical quality measures also known as Core Measures.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Office of County Counsel has reviewed and approved this agreement as to form, and the Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The agreement has also been reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee and by its Board of Trustees on January 8, 2021.

FINANCING:

The cost for this agreement is \$216,454 of which \$70,728 is included in the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Adopted Budget. Amounts for remaining years of the agreement will be included in those budgets as appropriate.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS STRATEGIC INITIATIVES:

This agreement is for a software system which allows data collection of process improvement projects as well as regulatory required reporting of quality metrics. The ability to capture this data and to compare with our peers helps drive improved medical care and patient outcomes at NMC. The use of this system provides NMC with the additional support it needs to be able to provide reliable and quality patient care, thus improving the health and quality of life for patients and their families.

NMC has obtained an independent opinion of fair market value supporting the payment terms of this Agreement.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION: UPDATE SUMMARY

Wolters Kluwer Health, Up-To-Date Inc. (UpToDate) is the leading web based clinical research tool that clinicians utilize for their day to day review of clinical topics. NMC is a teaching facility, and as such, web based research is particularly important for medical students and resident education. The user can access the UpToDate system via an internet links embedded within NMC's Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system, Medical Information Technology, Inc. (MEDITECH). UpToDate is a standalone resource application and there is no data exchanged to or from NMC systems with this application.

Currently NMC physicians, residents and medical students have access to Up-To-Date's web based research and educational materials online. In addition to research, physicians can receive required individual Continuing Medical Education (CME) credit each time Up-To-Date is logged into and utilized. Annual CME is required by NMC, state and national medical specialty boards thereby aiding NMC and its physicians in keeping current in meeting their continuing medical education requirements. With Up-to-Date access, clinicians are able to "click" on the Up-To-Date icon and are able to research the most recent evidenced based recommendations. As an example, when a physician is on call and must remotely enter antibiotic orders for pneumonia but has a question on the preferred medication, he or she will be able to "click" on the Up-to-Date icon and view the latest recommendation.

This amendment will extend the term an additional year. There is no change to the scope or services provided.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

Auditor-Controller reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The amendment No. 3 was reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee and Board of Trustees on January 08, 2021.

FINANCING:

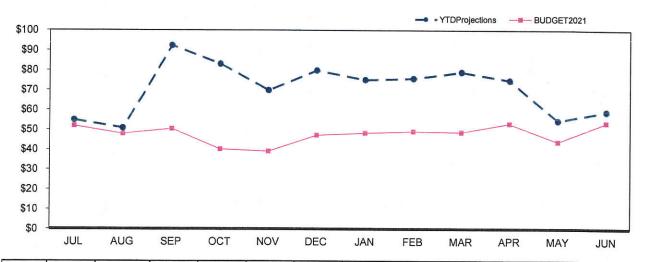

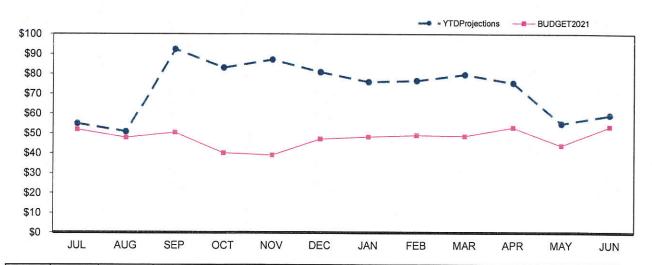
