SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

MD Buyline provides Natividad with access to its automated cost analysis services. These cost analysis services compare new equipment quotes against other current costs in the active marketplace in real time. The reports that are auto-generated will include a cost comparative analysis and also provide Natividad with suggestions as to which areas can be more easily negotiated down. Natividad has found these reports to be extremely helpful during the procurement of medical equipment to ensure it receives competitive pricing. As a result, Natividad can make new product decisions with greater efficiency, transparency and supporting documentation. The agreement also includes consulting services on an as-needed basis only specifically related to more detailed or complex equipment purchase agreements, including ongoing equipment maintenance agreements for products both in and out of warranty. Natividad believes utilizing these consulting services would yield the necessary inside-industry data that would provide Natividad more leverage to negotiate the cost down significantly on certain items.

For over 30 years, MD Buyline has provided hospitals with strategic sourcing data and advisory services supporting all types of medical equipment and technologies acquisitions including consumables.

Natividad is requesting that the agreement be extended to allow for services to continue.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Office of County Counsel reviewed and approved this renewal and amendment No. 2 as to form, and the Auditor-Controller reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Everbridge is a critical event management software system that has been utilized by Natividad since January 2018. It allows Natividad the ability to perform mass callings to all hospital staff and is utilized when there are notifications that need to get out to a large number of employees at once; this includes emergency situations and can be used if there are mass casualty/triage events. This system is also utilized to contact specific groups of people when needed during accreditation surveys (TJC, CMS, etc.) as an alternate means of communicating updates.

Everbridge is a web based system that stores telephone numbers for all staff members within the hospital in a single location. It is readily accessible from anywhere that has access to the internet. Within the system, NMC has the ability to select targeted groups of employees and in various ways. The system tracks the means of communication and allows Natividad to verify receipt of the communication with individual employees. Natividad is requesting renewal of the Everbridge agreement for a period of two years.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Office of County Counsel has reviewed and approved this amendment No. 3 as to form, and the Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The amendment No. 3 has also been reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee and by its Board of Trustees on January 14, 2022.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION: UPDATE SUMMARY

Wolters Kluwer Health, Up-To-Date Inc. (UpToDate) is the leading web based clinical research tool that clinicians utilize for their day to day review of clinical topics. NMC is a teaching facility, and as such, web-based research is particularly important for medical students and resident education. The user can access the UpToDate system via an internet links embedded within NMC's Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system, Medical Information Technology, Inc. (MEDITECH). UpToDate is a standalone resource application and there is no data exchanged to or from NMC systems with this application.

Currently NMC physicians, residents and medical students have access to Up-To-Date's web-based research and educational materials online. In addition to research, physicians can receive required individual Continuing Medical Education (CME) credit each time Up-To-Date is logged into and utilized. Annual CME is required by NMC, state and national medical specialty boards thereby aiding NMC and its physicians in keeping current in meeting their continuing medical education requirements. With Up-to-Date access, clinicians are able to "click" on the Up-To-Date icon and are able to research the most recent evidenced based recommendations. As an example, when a physician is on call and must remotely enter antibiotic orders for pneumonia but has a question on the preferred medication, he or she will be able to "click" on the Up-to-Date icon and view the latest recommendation.

This amendment will extend the term an additional year. There is no change to the scope or services provided.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Office of County Counsel reviewed and approved this amendment No. 4 as to form, and the Auditor-Controller reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The amendment No. 4 was reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee and Board of Trustees on January 14, 2022.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Imprivata OneSign is a Single Sign On (SSO) solution that enables NMC users to quickly and securely access clinical and administrative applications with one username and password. In the course of treating patients, personnel need to access multiple applications, including the MEDITECH electronic health record system. Prior to implementing Imprivata OneSign, the act of logging in/logging out of multiple systems throughout the workday had caused noticeable inefficiencies. The implementation of OneSign has resulted in an appreciable difference in time and staff resources. The Imprivata tool further speeds up access by utilizing the employee's badge and a reader as part of the sign-on process.

Another important capability of this system is an always-available employee self-service portal to aid with forgotten passwords and lockouts, further enhancing employee productivity.

This amendment includes scope increases with the addition of two Imprivata modules: Imprivata Identity Governance and Imprivata Privileged Access Management. Identity Governance is an end-

to-end solution with role-based access controls, automated network provisioning and deprovisioning, streamlined auditing processes, and analytics that enable faster security threat evaluation and remediation. Privileged Access Management is a tool for identity and access management of network administrator accounts.

This request includes the extension of maintenance and support for one (1) additional year, and the purchase and implementation of Identity Governance and Privileged Access Management, with three (3) years of maintenance and support.

The Request for Qualifications (RFQ) #9600-86, for architectural services was solicited on September 17, 2021 and received five (5) statement of qualification (SOQ) packages. Following staff's review and evaluation of the SOQ packages, all five (5) contractors were selected for awards based on their qualifications.

NMC's Master Agreements for architectural services are for a five (5) year term. The qualified contractors will be utilized by Natividad Medical Center for contracting out professional architectural services as needed. These Master Agreements enable NMC to have on-call the necessary qualified professionals to assist with both small scale and large scale building improvement projects at NMC, therefore there no imposed limit being set at either \$100,000 per project or over \$100,000 per project; these agreements cover both scenarios. Inclusion on this Master Agreement does not guarantee award of any projects.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the RFQ and the associated Agreement template as to legal form, and the Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. The Agreements have also been reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee and by its Board of Trustees on January 14, 2022.

FINANCING:

The aggregate cost for these Agreements is \$5,000,000, of which \$1,000,000 was included in the Adopted Budget for FY21-22. Amounts for remaining years of the Agreement will be included in those budgets as appropriate. There is no impact to the General Fund.

On March 28, 2018, Natividad issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 9600-80 for one or more new agreements for interior design services from qualified vendors. On May 3, 2018, NMC received only one proposal for consideration, which was from Gallun Snow.

Natividad entered into an agreement with Gallun Snow in August 2018. The agreement was for three years with an option to extend for two additional one-year periods. Natividad has continued its relationship with Gallun Snow and is now in the first one-year extension period. The workload with Gallun Snow has increased since the start of the contract. Some examples of current work are as follows: Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) finishes and furniture, Medical Surgical Unit 3 finishes and furniture, Mental Health Unit finishes, and Intensive Care Unit (ICU) finishes and furniture. The original amount of the agreement was \$600,000, and Natividad desires to increase the agreement by \$225,000 to ensure adequate funding through July 31, 2023.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Background

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 ("HIPAA") mandates that "Covered Entities" comply with specific rules intended to protect the privacy and security of health information. Natividad, as a public hospital, meets the definition of a covered entity and is therefore required to comply with HIPAA.

One of the HIPAA rules requires that a covered entity enter into a BAA with any entity who performs functions or activities on behalf of, or provides certain services to, a covered entity that involve access to PHI. The purpose of the BAA is to ensure that the BA will appropriately safeguard PHI. In addition to these contractual obligations, BAs are directly liable for compliance with certain provisions of the HIPAA rules.

Natividad has, in the past, presented the Board with a BAA template for consideration and approval. The template has served as the basis for contract negotiations with current and potential BAs. The last revision was approved by the Board in October 2016. Natividad also requested and was granted authority to implement future changes to the BAA template and to execute further revised BAAs, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, for a period of five (5) years.

Overview of Revised Business Associate Agreement template

The attached BAA template is a written contract between the County, doing business as NMC, a

covered entity, and the County's vendor that meets the definition of a BA. The Agreement:

- Establishes the permitted and required uses and disclosures of PHI by the BA
- Provides that the BA will not use or further disclose the information other than as permitted or required by the contract or as required by law
- Requires the BA to implement appropriate safeguards to prevent unauthorized use or disclosure of the information, including implementing requirements of the HIPAA Security Rule
- Requires the BA to report to the covered entity any use or disclosure of the information not provided for by its contract, including incidents that constitute breaches of unsecured PHI

The revisions include:

- Updates that ensure compliance with the California Confidentiality law, including the State breach notification requirements.
- Updates that reflect the current healthcare compliance environment
- Provisions that improve the management of County risk
- Editing for conciseness and to eliminate any duplicative provisions

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has assisted in the development of the updated BAA template and has reviewed and approved the revision for legal form and legality. The NMC BAA template was reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee and Board of Trustees on January 14, 2022.

FINANCING:

There is no cost associated with this request.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Natividad operates medical surgical units and an acute rehabilitation unit that provide direct patient care to hospitalized patients 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. It requires a team of internal medicine and family medicine physicians, known as hospitalists to sufficiently staff these units and provide 24/7 patient care.

Natividad would like to amend its existing agreement with Sound Physicians to provide sufficient staffing of these critical units with at least four physicians during the day and one physician at night who are immediately available to provide patient care. Sound Physicians also provides a Chief Hospitalist physician, a registered nurse and management services for the management and oversight of the hospitalist program to ensure quality patient care.

Natividad has obtained an independent opinion of fair market value supporting the payment terms of this Agreement.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has reviewed and approved this Amendment as to legal form. Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved this Amendment as to fiscal provisions. The Amendment has also been reviewed and approved by Natividad's Finance Committee and Board of Trustees.

FINANCING:

The cost of this Amendment is \$6,044,424. The total cost of this Agreement is \$14,140,032 for the period March 1, 2019 to February 29, 2024 (60 months). \$2,698,536 is included in the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Adopted Budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.

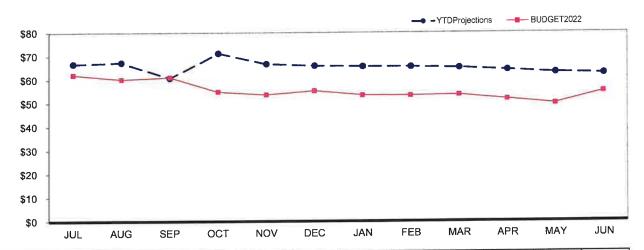

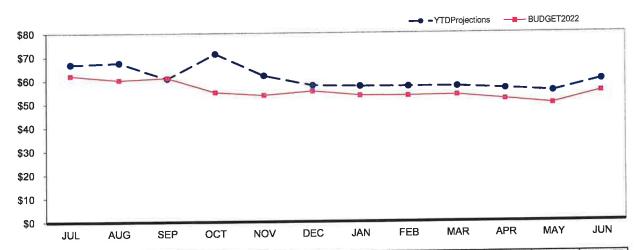
