

People 50 Years or Older May Get More Health Care Benefits

Medi-Cal provides free or low-cost health care to people who qualify. If you're age 50 or older, you may be eligible for full scope medical benefits, regardless of immigration status.

Expanded benefits are effective May 1, 2022.

Full Scope Medi-Cal Covers These Services:

- Doctor visits
- Emergency care
- Outpatient specialty services
- Hospital care
- Dental
- Vision
- Hearing
- Mental health care
- Medications
- Substance use disorder services
- And more

Who Can Apply for the Older Adult Expansion?

- Ages 50 and older
- Income less than 138% of the federal poverty level
- Any immigration status
